It was moved and seconded to close the meeting to the public in accordance with NRS 241.030 to discuss financial matters. MOTION CARRIED.

<u>CUSTOM STRUCTURES INC.</u>, (B-2 RESIDENTIAL AND SAMLL COMMERCIAL) NEW APPLICATION

Applicant was present. The application was approved contingent upon applicant furnishing staff with proof of \$50,000 working capital.

a. DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

6. INFORMAL SETTLEMENTS: RANDY SCHAEFER, HEARING OFFICER

a. AIR MAX, LICENSE NOS. 53647, 54794

It was moved and seconded to accept the Stipulated Settlement Agreement. The Respondent is to reimburse the Board for Investigative Costs of \$448 within 30 days and a Warning Letter shall be placed in Respondent's file. MOTION CARRIED. Mr. Schaefer abstained.

b. PERRINO COLLETTI, INC. dba ELITE FLOORING, LICENSE NO. 55185

It was moved and seconded to accept the Stipulated Settlement Agreement. The Respondent is to pay an Administrative Fine of \$1,000 and reimburse the Board for Investigative Costs of \$465 within 30 days. A Warning Letter shall be placed in Respondent's file. MOTION CARRIED. Mr. Schaefer abstained.

c. AQUARIUS LANDSCAPE & SPRINKLER CO., INC., LICENSE NO. 19009

It was moved and seconded to accept the Stipulated Settlement Agreement. The Respondent is to pay an Administrative Fine of \$500 and a Residential Recovery Fund fine of \$100 plus reimburse the Board for Investigative Costs of \$617 within 30 days. MOTION CARRIED. Mr. Schaefer abstained.

7. ADVISORY OPINIONS:

a. LONDON BRIDGE MARINE CORP.:

London Bridge Marine Corp. withdrew their request for an Advisory Opinion.

b. A ALL-SAFE SAFETY BARRIERS:

A All-Safe Safety Barriers requested an advisory opinion to determine if a contractor license was required to install removable fencing.

Based upon the information provided, the Board opined that a C-25 or an A-21 license classification is required for the installation of removable fencing, which requires the coring or bolting into a concrete slab or other permanent fixture in order to secure the fencing.

8. REPORT OF COMPLAINT REVIEW:

WHITAKER ENTERPRISES, LICENSE NO. 31695A

Mr. Lyford provided a summary of the complaints against Whitaker Enterprises for the last 5 years. The Board requested the summary report be provided to Mr. Whitaker for his review and input. The matter is to be placed on the October 28, 2003 agenda for Board action.
