# 1. DAN CHANEYS PRIMARY COLOR, LICENSE #42728

Daniel F. Chaney, Owner William Downey, Homeowner R-0207-004-RF

No one from Dan Chaneys Primary Color was present.

William Downey, Homeowner; Investigator Gary Leonard; and Director of Investigations George Lyford were sworn.

Mr. George Lyford explained the claim filed by William Downey is for non-completion by Dan Chaneys Primary Color of an interior painting job of a home located at 720 Lincoln Highway, Zephyr Cove, Nevada. The contract amount was \$13,847.00, of which the Downeys paid Dan Chaneys Primary Color \$13,000.00. The painting was approximately 80% completed, but not within the scope of the original contract, and the workmanship was not within industry standards.

Investigator Gary Leonard testified that in addition to the \$13,000.00 paid toward the contract, he verified an amount of \$1,195 was spent for drywall repairs, totaling an amount of \$14,995.00 out of pocket from the claimant.

MS. CAVIN MOVED TO AWARD THE CLAIMANT \$15,000.00 BASED UPON THE EVIDENCE AND TESTIMONY GIVEN.

MR. HIGGINS SECOND THE MOTION AND THE MOTION CARRIED.

#### 2. BLADES CONSTRUCTION, LICENSE #23397

Jerry Lee Blades, Owner Tammy Christopherson, Homeowner L-0111-013-RF

No one from Blades Construction was present.

Mr. Soren Christopherson & Mrs. Tammy Christopherson, Investigator Gary Hoid and Director of Investigations George Lyford were sworn in.

Mr. George Lyford explained the claim filed by Mr. and Mrs. Christopherson is for failure to construct kitchen cabinets to the specifications in the contract by Blades Construction. The contract price for the cabinets was \$17,563.00 of which \$15,148.26 has been paid.

Investigator Gary Hoid testified that the job was 100% complete but the workmanship was not within industry standards.

MR. HIGGINS MOVED TO AWARD THE CLAIMANT \$15,150.00 BASED UPON THE EVIDENCE AND TESTIMONY GIVEN.

MS. CAVIN SECONDED THE MOTION AND THE MOTION CARRIED.

#### 4. CARSON VALLEY WHOLESALE FLOORING, LICENSE #47950

Charles David Manning, Owner Michael A. Givens, Homeowner R-0209-105-RF

No one from Carson Valley Wholesale Flooring was present.

Investigator Gary Hoid and Director of Investigations George Lyford, Michael & Kathy Givens were sworn in.

Mr. George Lyford explained the claim filed by Mr. & Mrs. Givens is for failure to complete tile floors to the specifications in the contract by Carson Valley Wholesale Flooring. The contract price for the tile floor was \$3,400.00 of which the claimant has paid the full amount.

Investigator Gary Hoid testified that the tile flooring was 100% complete but the workmanship was not within industry standards.

MS. CAVIN MOVED TO AWARD THE CLAIMANT \$3,400.00 BASED UPON THE EVIDENCE AND TESTIMONY GIVEN.

MR. HIGGINS SECONDED THE MOTION AND THE MOTION CARRIED.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:30 p.m.
