## **Task Force Locates and Arrests Local Fugitive**

**(Reno, NV)** – The Inter-Agency Construction Task Force captured convicted felon, Victor Moore after Code Enforcement officers and Nevada State Contractors Board investigators encountered him among four suspects who were building a brick wall and landscaping at a Reno area residence.

Moore fled the scene on foot as the investigators approached. The suspect was found hiding in a nearby desert area approximately one mile away. Deputies from Washoe County Sheriff's Department responded and the suspect was taken into custody. Moore was found to be on probation for a stalking charge. He was issued citations for violation of Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 624.700, Contracting without a license and NRS 199.280, Obstructing/delaying a peace officer. Moore was then transported and booked for the felony probation violation at the Washoe County jail.

“This is an excellent example of the effectiveness of close cooperation between agencies,” says NSCB Executive Officer, Margi Grein.

Citations were also issued to the other suspects at the jobsite for violations of NRS 624.700, Contracting without a license and 624.720 Unlawful advertising.

Unlicensed contracting is a crime in Nevada. NRS 624 makes contracting without a license a Misdemeanor for the first offense, a Gross Misdemeanor for the second offense, and a class E Felony for the third offense.
