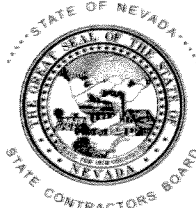

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STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD

MINUTES OF THE WORKSHOP BEFORE THE NEVADA STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD HELD OCTOBER 11, 2012

Executive Officer Margi Grein called the workshop to order at 9:00 A.M. on Thursday, October 11, 2012 at the offices of the State Contractors Board, 2310 Corporate Circle, Henderson, Nevada, and video-conferenced to the Reno office. Exhibits 1 and 2 are the Notices of Intent to Act Upon a Regulation and a copy of the proposed regulations.

Ms. Grein explained the purpose of the workshop is to receive public comment on three proposed regulations, Legislative Counsel Bureau file numbers R095-12, R096-12, and R098-12. Ms. Grein noted the two notices for the workshop and hearing were posted in accordance with NRS 233B at the Paseo Verde Library, Sawyer State Building, Clark County Library, the Washoe County Courthouse, Washoe County Library, Reno City Hall, offices of the State Contractors Board in Reno and Henderson, and on the agency's website.

Ms. Grein explained the proposed regulation changes to item R095-12 amend the language of classifications A-8, A-19, C-2, C-2g, C-4a, C-15a, C-16, C-36, and C-38a; add four new subclassifications: A-24 (Fountains and Other Water Features), A-25 (Telecommunications Towers), C-14j (Conveyance of Goods), and C-41d (Private Fire Hydrants); and clarifies and streamlines the language making it more consistent with current trade practices, as well as repeals language that is no longer needed or that is already addressed in other sections of the law.

Ms. Grein noted there were members of the public present for comment on proposed regulation R095-12.

Mr. Modesto Gaxiola, Business Manager, representing the Roofers and Water Proofers Union provided comments concerning the origin of polyurethane products and how the product is used today as a protector for various purposes. Mr. Gaxiola indicated his union would like to see urethane coating added to classification C-15.

Mr. Jack Mallory, Director of Government Affairs, representing the International Union of Painters and Allied Trades, agreed with Mr. Gaxiola's comments and added that it is appropriate to have urethane coatings in subclassifications C-4 and C-36 because the product is not solely limited to roofing applications. Mr. Mallory also supports leaving urethane in the C-16 subclassification.

Mr. Danny Costella, Agent, representing the Ironworkers Local 118, sought clarification on the changes made to C-14 and the purpose of creating a subclassification for the construction of communication towers. Ms. Mathias indicated the intent of the proposal was in response to a growing number of specialty licenses being issued for companies constructing communication towers.

Ms. Grein closed the discussion period for R095-12 and sought comments on R096-12. Ms. Grein noted the proposed regulation amends the language of subclassifications C-3a to remove the term "remodeling" and clarify the scope of work, and subclassification C-3c to include the installation of firestop systems as part of the scope of work.

Mr. Jack Mallory, Director of Government Affairs, representing the International Union of Painters and Allied Trades, sought clarification on whether the amendment would allow a C-3 contractor to install glazing systems. Ms. Mathias responded it was not the intent of the Board to allow C-3 contractors to install glazing systems. Mr. Costella expressed concern with the language and sought to ensure the C-3 classification would not be permitted to install curtain walls or perform structural steel work. Interested parties were asked to provide proposed amendments.

Ms. Grein closed the discussion period for R096-12 and sought comments on R098-12. Ms. Grein noted the proposed regulation reduces penalties for the late filing of a renewal application, clarifies language concerning motions, and repeals language no longer needed or that is already addressed in other sections of the law.

It was noted that no members of the public were present in either Reno or Henderson to comment on the proposed regulation.

Ms. Grein stated that a hearing on the three proposed regulations will be held Thursday, November 1, 2012 at 9:00 A.M.


Ms. Grein advised members of the public to submit their comments in writing to the Board for inclusion in the November 1, 2012 hearing materials.
