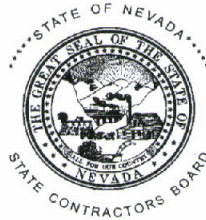

ALJ Allison found Respondent guilty of one (1) violation of NRS 624.3017(1) workmanship not commensurate with the standards of the trade in general; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5), as set forth in NAC 624.700(3)(a) failure to comply with the Board's Notice to Correct; and one (1) violation of NRS 624.302(6) failure to comply with a written request by the Board. The Third, Fifth and Sixth Alleged Violations were dismissed. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$1,000.00 for each of the First and Second Alleged Violation; a fine of \$500.00 for each of the Fourth Alleged Violation for total fines of \$2,500.00 and investigative costs of \$2,179.00.
