MINUTES OF THE MEETING

March 12, 2020

CALL TO ORDER:

Noah Allison, Esq. called the meeting of the State Contractors Board to order at 8:30 a.m., Thursday, March 12, 2020, State Contractors Board, Henderson and Reno, Nevada. Exhibit A is the Meeting Agenda and Exhibit B is the Sign in Log.

Ms. Grein stated the agenda was posted in compliance with the open meeting law on March 4, 2020, at Paseo Verde Library, Sawyer State Building and Clark County Library. The agenda was also posted in both offices of the Board, Henderson and Reno and on the Board's Internet Website.

1. DISCIPLINARY HEARING: (Continued from December 12, 2019 and February 19, 2020)

SPIKE CONSTRUCTION, INC., License Nos. 59148, 62942

Licensee was present but not represented by counsel at the hearing.

Exhibit B - Respondent's additional exhibits to include a statement from Jerry Prodoehl; a statement from Alexander Levkoff; respondent's list of open contracts and status of projects; a Clark County Inspection Record; and 2 bank verification forms completed by Respondent's bank.

ALJ Allison found Respondent guilty of three (3) violations of NRS 624.305(1) for no license may be used by any person other than the person to whom such license is issued; two (2) violations of NRS 624.302(5) failure to respond to a written request from the Board; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3011(1)(b)(1) violation of the building laws of the State; two (2) violations of NRS 624.3015(1) acting in the capacity of a contractor beyond the scope of the license; two (2) violations of NRS 624.302(6) failure to comply with a written request by the Board; two (2) violations of NRS 624.3016(1) any fraudulent or deceitful act committed in the capacity of a contractor; one (1) violation of NRS 624.302(7) failure to comply with an order of the Board; and, one (1) violation of NRS 624.3018(2) certain persons are prohibited from serving as officer, director, associate or partner of licensee. The Second, Third, Eleventh, Twelfth, Fifteenth, Seventeenth, Eighteenth, and Twentieth alleged violations are dismissed. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$5,000.00 for the First Alleged Violation; a fine of \$500.00 for the Fourth Alleged Violation; a fine of \$2,000.00 for the Fifth Alleged Violation; a fine of \$1,000.00 for the Sixth Alleged Violation; a fine of \$500.00 for the Seventh Alleged Violation; a fine of \$5,000.00 for the Eighth Alleged Violation; a fine of \$2,000.00 for the Ninth Alleged Violation; a fine of \$500.00 for the Tenth Alleged Violation; a fine of \$5,000.00 for the Thirteenth Alleged Violation; a fine of \$2,000.00 for the Fourteenth Alleged Violation; a fine of \$500.00 for the Sixteenth Alleged Violation; a fine of \$500.00 for the Nineteenth Alleged Violation; and, guilt with no fine on the Twenty-first Alleged Violation, for total fines of \$24,500.00 and investigative costs of \$7,052.00. License numbers 59148 and 62942 are revoked.
