

Norma DeLibertis of Las Vegas were selected to have one room of their home remodeled as part of the "2nd Annual Rebuilding Hope" community service program.

Volunteers from the Associated Builders and Contractors of Southern Nevada, with support from the Nevada State Contractors Board, are remodeling the DeLibertis bathroom. The program was limited to the first 100 applications, received from

Nov. 12 through Dec. 31, 2007. Applications were judged on a family's *special circumstances* or *needs*.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, the DeLibertises had to assume parental responsibility of their three grandchildren, ages 1 to 3.
