Rebuilding Hope" community service program.

Volunteers from the ABC will be doing the remodeling, scheduled to begin in early

March, with support from the Nevada State Contractors Board and select community businesses.

This year's Rebuilding Hope program was limited to the first 100 applications, received from Dec. 8, 2008, through Jan. 31, 2009. Applications were judged on a family's *special circumstances* or *needs*.

Williams is a disabled senior citizen, living on a fixed income. The kitchen in her home, built in 1964, needs to be completely remodeled.
