



NEVADA STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD NEWS RELEASE

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CONTRACTORS BOARD SUSPENDS FIVE, REVOKES ONE LICENSE; DURING APRIL DISCIPLINARY HEARINGS

LAS VEGAS and RENO, NEV. – The Nevada State Contractors Board took disciplinary action against licensed contractors for violations of Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 624 during its April hearings, including placing five licenses on suspension, revoking one, and affirming the immediate voluntary surrender of another. A total of \$6,800 in fines and \$3,587 in restitution were issued.

Under Nevada Revised Statutes, a licensee is subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failure to comply with the requirements of the laws or regulations governing contractors. Violations may result in Board action against the contractor’s license. The State Contractors Board has the power to regulate contractors and discipline licensees who violate NRS 624. Disciplinary action may consist of a fine, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action

The NSCB has the responsibility to promote quality construction by Nevada licensed contractors through a regulatory licensing system designed to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public.
