**NEVADA STATE COMMISSION ON CONSTRUCTION EDUCATION MEETING HELD TUESDAY,
MARCH 19, 2019 AT THE STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD LOCATED AT
2310 CORPORATE CIRCLE, HENDERSON, NEVADA 89074**

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the Nevada State Commission on Construction Education was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Shawn Danoski at 9:00 a.m. Mr. Timothy Geswein, Esq. was present, as well as Nevada State Contractors Board Executive Officer Margi Grein, Board Member Guy Wells, Licensing Administrator Nancy Mathias, and Administrative Assistant Diana Wallace. As part of its strategic planning discussion, the Commission also reviewed its existing goals and strategic objectives, which included recommendations for revisions to the grant application forms, rating process and quarterly reports.
