ALJ Allison found Respondent LV House Doctor guilty one (1) violation of NRS 624.3014(2)(a) aiding or abetting an unlicensed person to evade the provisions of this chapter; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3011(1)(b)(1) violation of the building laws of the State; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3015(1) acting in the capacity of a contractor beyond the scope of the license. The Second, Fifth, Sixth and Seventh Causes of Action were dismissed. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$500.00 for the First Cause of Action; a fine of \$250.00 for each of the Third and Fourth Causes of Action for total fines of \$1,000.00 and investigative costs of \$2,522.00. Fines and investigative costs are to be paid within sixty (60) days of the June 20, 2018 hearing or license number 76906, C & C Specialties, LLC, dba LV House Doctor shall be suspended. Respondent is to provide a current compliant financial statement with bank verification form for all cash accounts that

support the license limit of license number 78533, C & C Specialties, LLC, dba LV Yard Doctor along with an active workers' compensation policy within sixty (60) days of the June 20, 2018 hearing. Upon compliance with the Board's Decision and Order, Respondent may file an application with the Board to inactivate license number 76906, C & C Specialties, LLC, dba LV House Doctor.

AQUARIUS LANDSCAPE & SPRINKLER CO., INC., dba AQUARIUS LANDSCAPING,

License No. 19009

ALJ Allison found Respondent guilty one (1) violation of NRS 624.3015(1) acting in the capacity of a contractor beyond the scope of the license; one (1) violation of NRS 624.302(5) failure to respond to a written request from the Board; one (1) violation of NRS 624.302(6) failure to comply with a written request by the Board; and one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility. The Third Cause of Action was dismissed. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$1,000.00 for the First Cause of Action; a fine of \$500.00 for each of the Second, Fourth and Fifth Causes of Action for total fines of \$2,500.00 and investigative costs of \$2,010.00. Respondent's license, number 19009 shall be suspended until Respondent provides a current compliant financial statement with bank verification form that supports the license limit. Fines and investigative costs are to be paid and a current financial statement provided within ninety (90) days of the June 20, 2018 hearing or license number 19009, Aquarius Landscape & Sprinkler Co., dba Aquarius Landscaping shall be revoked.

KOMAX DEVELOPMENT, INC., License No. 67413

Licensee was present and represented by Tony May, Esq. at the hearing.

ALJ Allison found Respondent guilty one (1) violation of NRS 624.302(5) failure to respond to a written request from the Board and one (1) violation of NRS 624.302(6) failure to comply with a written request from the Board. The First, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth and Eighth Causes of Action were dismissed. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$500.00 for each of the First and Seventh Causes of Action for total fines of \$1,000.00 and investigative costs of \$5,875.00. License limit lowered to \$550,000.00. License number 67413, Komax Development, Inc. shall be reactivated. Fines and investigative costs are to be paid within sixty (60) days of the June 20, 2018 hearing or license number 67413, Komax Development, Inc. shall be revoked.

a. UNIVERSAL ELECTRIC CONTRACTORS, LLC, dba UNIVERSAL ELECTRIC & SOLAR,

License No. 76589

Licensee was not present nor represented by counsel at the hearing.

ALJ Allison found Respondent Universal Electric Contractors, LLC, dba Universal Electric & Solar, license number 76589 in default and adopted the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law as set forth in the Administrative complaint. Respondent was found guilty of four (4) violations of NRS 624.3012(2) failure to pay any money when due; two (2) violations of NRS 624.302(5) failure to respond to a written request from the Board; one (1) violation of NRS 624.302(6) failure to comply with a written request by the Board; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3016(1) any fraudulent or deceitful act committed in the capacity of a contractor; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3011(1)(b)(2) violation of the safety laws or labor laws of this State; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5), as set forth in NAC 624.640(5) failure to include its license number and monetary license limit on its contracts; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5), as set forth in NAC 624.640(3) failure to notify the Board of a change of address within 30 days; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(4) failure to keep in force the bond for the full period required by the Board; and one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$1,000.00 for each of the First, Second, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh and Eighth Causes of Action; a fine of \$250.00 for each of the Third, Fourth, Ninth, Tenth, Eleventh and Twelfth Causes of Action; a fine of \$500.00 for each of the Thirteenth and Fourteenth Causes of Action for total fines of \$8,500.00 and investigative costs of \$3,395.00. License number 76589, Universal Electric Contractors, LLC, dba Universal Electric & Solar was revoked. Respondent is required to make full restitution to all damaged parties and reimburse the Board for any monies paid out of the Residential Recovery Fund plus pay the fines and investigative costs prior to consideration of future licensure.

b. MAINTENANCE BROS., LLC, License No. 80530

Licensee was not present nor represented by counsel at the hearing.

ALJ Allison found Respondent Maintenance Bros., LLC, license number 80530 in default and adopted the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law as set forth in the Administrative complaint. Respondent was found guilty of one (1) violation of NRS 624.3012(2) failure to pay any money when due; one (1) violation of NRS 624.302(5) failure to respond to a written request from the Board; one (1) violation of NRS 624.302(6) failure to comply with a written request by the Board; and one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$1,000.00 for the First Cause of Action; a fine of \$250.00 for each of the Second and Third Causes of Action; a fine of \$500.00 for the Fourth Cause of Action for total fines of \$2,000.00 and investigative costs of \$2,074.00. License number 80530, Maintenance Bros., LLC was revoked. Respondent is required to make full restitution to all damaged parties and reimburse the Board for any monies paid out of the Residential Recovery Fund plus pay the fines and investigative costs prior to consideration of future licensure.
