2. DISCIPLINARY HEARING – DEFAULT HEARING:

C R Construction, LLC, dba C 1 Construction, License Nos. 78295, 80606

The licensee was not present.

ALJ Addison found Respondent C R Construction LLC dba, C 1 Construction, license numbers 78295 and 80606 in default and adopted the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as set forth in the

Administrative complaint. Licensee was found guilty of (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5), Specifically, NRS 624.256 (9) proof of industrial insurance, (1) violation of NRS 624.302(6) failure to comply, (1) violation of NRS 624.3018(2) two companies and (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(3) failure to provide a current financial statement. License numbers 78295 and 80606 were revoked. Respondent shall pay a fine of a total fine in the amount of \$800 and reimburse the Board for investigative costs of \$1,496 and any claims and associated expenses that may be paid out of the Residential Recovery Fund prior to re-licensure.

3. DISCIPLINARY HEARING – DEFAULT HEARING:

Grizzly Construction LLC, License No. 82526

The licensee was not present.

ALJ Addison found Respondent Grizzly Construction LLC, license number 82526 in default and adopted the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as set forth in the Administrative complaint. Licensee was found guilty of (1) violation of NRS 624.3017(1) substandard workmanship, (4) violation of NRS 624.302(5) failure to comply, (2) violations of NRS 624.3011(1)(a)(b)(1) willful or deliberate disregard and violation of the building laws of the State, (5) violations of NRS 624.3012(1) diversion of money received for the completion of a specific construction project, (4) violations of NRS 624.301(1) abandonment without legal excuse of any construction project or operation engaged in or undertaken by the licensee as a contractor, (1) violation of NRS 624.305(1)(2) unlawful use, assignment or transfer of license, (2) violations of NRS 624.3016(6) for its failure to comply with NRS 624.600, (2) violations of NRS 624.3013(5) pursuant to NRS 624.520(1) failure to provide Residential Recovery Fund Notice to owner, (1) violation of NRS 624.3012(2) failure to pay for materials and services (1) violation of NRS 624.301(2) abandonment of a construction project when the percentage of the project completed in less than the percentage of the total price of the contract paid and (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility. License number 82526 was revoked. Respondent shall pay a fine in the amount of \$16,600 and reimburse the Board for investigative costs of \$4,032 and any claims and associated expenses that may be paid out of the Residential Recovery Fund prior to re-licensure.

4. FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY HEARING:

DESERT GLAZING INC DBA EMERALD GLASS, License No. 83371

Licensee was not present.

ALJ Addison found the Respondent guilty of violating NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility and NRS 624.302 (5) failing to comply with an order of the Board.
