Appearances are made in person by Homeowners, Lawrence Jones and Wendy Garrod; counsel for Homeowners, Kelly Burton Esq.; Respondent, Dennis Zachary, Donald "Butch" Williams, Esq.; Tracy Truman, Esq.; Appearing as witnesses for Respondent are Teresa Miller; Ed Esquivil and Michael Mallett; Prosecutor Jack Juan, Esq.; Terry Wike, Compliance Supervisor, Raymond Zack, Compliance Investigator. The Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) asks Prosecutor and Respondent's counsel if they have any procedural issues that need to be addressed. Prosecutor waives, and Respondent's counsel advises the ALJ that Respondent has procedural issue with res judicate and collateral estoppel.
